Space Available:

There are two townhouses available for PA students during the didactic phase of the program. Each house can accommodate five students of the same gender. Housing assignments will be considered on a first come, first served basis.

What's Included:

All utilities, Internet, laundry facilities, convenience to class and campus dining.

Meals:

Students are required to purchase a graduate residential meal plan. This plan gives students 100 meal swipes per semester, which can be used at SNU Dining or traded for specially marked meals at Chick-fil-A, and \$50 Flex Money to spend at any on campus dining location or coffee shop.

Cost:

Housing is \$800/month with a \$150 non-refundable deposit (billed by semester). Meal plans are \$900/semester.

Sign Up:

A link will be provided to students after they are accepted to the SNU PA Program. Students will be required to sign a twelve-month housing contract that includes Community Living Guidelines.
